ABOUT THIS PROJECT

The HOPE4Schools project is co-financed by the European Commission through **Erasmus +**

It is a project carried out during 24 months, between 01.01.2022 and 31.12.2024.

OBJECTIVES



- Equip school staff, pupils and NGOs with relevant info in order to develop new competencies: understanding mental health, improving health communication, resilience and stress management through training and workshops by using the repository.
- Equip school staff, trainers and parents with tips and advice on how to talk with pupils about Covid-19, mental health and well-being, through interactive digital tools.
- Embrace the new educational and learning online methods (online repository resources and best practice example) by using digital technologies (Kahoot, Jamboard, Nearpod, Padlet, Canva, Mentimeter, etc.) and familiarizes trainers, teachers and students with them.
- Development of an interdisciplinary culture of well-being throughout the whole school and encourage academic improvement by embedding the well-being methodology in the school strategy and developing a concrete action plan.

RESULTS OF THE PROJECT

1. a well-being methodology for school staff and pupils with new strategies to use in school and the requirements in this regard;
2. an online resource repository containing useful resources, tips and advice, tools and techniques for school staff, pupils and parents;
3. a best practice collection on well-being topics for school staff and specialists.


