














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School practices - Game activity



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School practices – Game activity

This is an activity game - A fun way to improve teacher-student relationship. This is an indoor group activity.

Step 1:

Organise three different spaces in the classroom (e.g. one in the front, one in the back and one in the middle of the room). Get students to line up by height, birthday and shirt color following the three different spaces. Depending on the category chosen from those three (height, birthday, and shirt color), students must go to the specific place, interact, and learn more about each other. E.g. Those who are the same height or similar one goes to the space in the middle of the class, etc.

Step 2:

Start off the class game with the following sentence 'What movement activities could we do in class on a rainy day...' Based on this each group-category begins to mime different activities to speak.

Step 3:

Once finalized, the next person must add to the story without repeating information or getting stuck, so see how long you can keep it going! The game ends when the students start repeating the same movements too many times or become noisy.
